## MARINE EXCHANGE OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA

### MARITIME INFORMATION DEPARTMENT

The Marine Exchange of Southern California has earned the reputation for being the “honest broker” in collecting, compiling, and disseminating maritime information, and is highly regarded as the “trusted maritime information clearinghouse” for producing proven and accurate products, services, and reports to the waterfront business community. With a focus on the five major ports in Southern California (Los Angeles, Long Beach, San Diego, Port Hueneme, and the Chevron Offshore Terminal in El Segundo), the Marine Exchange has customers across the nation and around the world.

We prepare and transmit reports twice daily by mail, fax, e-mail, and web access at [www.mxsocal.org](http://www.mxsocal.org) using a log-on and password. Enhancements are constantly being made to include more features, services, and information in response to customer requests. This helps us serve the maritime industry and waterfront business community better now and in the future.

#### DAILY TRAFFIC REPORTS

Subscribers receive detailed reports that include information such as the vessels name, estimated time of arrival and departure, size, tonnage, cargo class, cargo carried, destination, origination, owner, operator, agent, assigned berth or anchorage, purpose of port call, Lloyds of London data, and other vital vessel information.

Reports are generated daily at 0700 and 1200. Popular reports include the Advance Arrival

Report; Daily Arrival, Shift, and Departure Logs; Active Vessels Inport; and Sail and Shift reports.

On-line web access, updated at 5 minute intervals, is also available.

Prices start at \$30/month, there are package rates, and discounts for semi-annual/annual payments.

#### MONTHLY COMPOSITE AND SPECIAL REPORTS

Monthly Composite Reports contain statistical summaries of arrival and departure information for the ports of Southern California. These reports contain information such as breakdown by bunkers, company, classification, flag, nature of service, and net tons.

The Marine Exchange has archived information back to its founding in 1923, and electronic data since 1994. Our Maritime Information Specialists can prepare custom, *ad-hoc* reports for customers upon request to meet their specific information needs. Fees for these reports are assessed based on customer request and amount of data in the report. Please call the Maritime Information Department for more information and pricing of these types of requests.

#### TARGET MAPPING

The Marine Exchange offers its “Target Mapping” service for Southern California waters, which is a stripped down display of our full Vessel Traffic Service display. All targets received using the Automated Identification System (AIS), and radar targets acquired by the VTS can be displayed on any computer with

Internet access using a log-on and password. The display is 90 seconds behind real time and has both chart-like displays and Google Earth. Cost is \$100/month for subscribers and \$150/month for non-subscribers.

#### OTHER SERVICES

**Port Handbooks:** We produce a handbook of maritime information such as agents, ship operators, cargo and harbor services, intermodal services, berth information, and professional services offered in Southern California. With more than 1,000 listings, it provides the most comprehensive source of current business listings and government contacts within the maritime industry. This publication is updated annually to keep it fresh and accurate. Cost is \$40 and we offer discounts.

**Cell Phone Rentals:** We offer cell phone rentals while vessels are in port. Phones can be rented through the ship’s agent for \$25/day. We are happy to deliver to the agents’ office and pick them up once the vessel has sailed. We deliver to LA/LB only and are unable to deliver to the berth.
